June 18th: Garrie D. Woolery and Backstage Pass-

- “Take Classic Rock N Roll, add some soulful blues with cool harmonica licks, mix in some country rock and southern rock, top it off with rocky top on the banjo, what you have is a very talented group of musicians and excellent entertainers, called Garrie D. Woolery and Backstage Pass.”

July 2nd: Lisa Biales Band

- A local (Oxford, OH) acoustic blues musician, performed at VOA the past 2 years.

- Her most recent CD, Belle of the Blues, delivers a “diverse set of material that feels right at home with Lisa’s passionate in-the-pocket vocals, which have a slant of southern sass to them.”
